From 19th-century antiques to minimalist modern pieces, those in the market for furniture today can find a wide range of options that didn't exist in Austin even a decade ago.

ANNIE DOWNING INTERIORS

Opened in 2016 in what has quickly become a mini design district downtown, Annie Downing Interiors offers everything from accessories to upholstered furniture to art. Barware, trays, lighting, pillows, blankets, dining chairs, case goods, rugs and small items that make great gifts also are available. ANTHROPOLOGIE

The national chain that deals in French flea market chic offers a plethora of home goods. Furniture, bedding, room and wall decor, rugs, curtains and lighting all are available in the Anthropologie showroom. AT HOME

Formerly known as Garden Ridge, this rebranded home decor superstore makes airplane hangars look small. It offers more than 50,000 items, including seasonal and holiday decor, patio furniture, home furnishings, wall art and decorative accents, rugs and housewares at relatively low prices. B&B ITALIA

The high-end Italian furniture brand famous for its modern style and forward-thinking design opened a showroom on West Sixth Street in 2016. Located in the former NEST Modern space, the 7,000-square-foot showroom is larger than B&B Italia's other Texas showrooms, in Houston and Dallas, and is a "mono-brand" showroom (meaning: only B&B Italia products). 1009 W. BACK HOME

Open to the trade only, Caffrey's is best known for its upholstered furniture, which can be custom made to fit a client's preferences for size, fabric, color and stitching, among other things.
